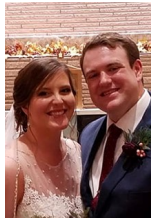
MINISTRY ENRICHMENT DAY

It has been noted that every Catholic household should have a Catholic Bible and the Catechism of the Catholic Church. This week we will continue our discussion about the contents of the Catechism of the Catholic Church.

Why is the Catechism so useful?

- For looking up questions or topics from the index
- The only Catholic book that should be used more often is the Bible
- For study of a given topic, e.g. the commandments
- For parishioners who want to have more knowledge of their faith
- For assisting with the defense of the faith
- As a reference when developing a class on a topic.
- Often books reference the Catechism. E.g. cc 190
- Use of the footnotes to launch into an even greater study of the faith

The first topic is quite useful for finding out answers to questions that you have or that others ask of you.

ALTAR SERVER BLESSING

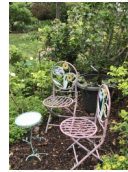
