GODPARENT INFORMATION

As you are selecting the godparents for your child, please keep in mind the following church laws (See also the Godparent form for more detail):

1. Only one male or one female godparent or one of each sex is allowed as godparents. (c. 873)
2. Must be at least 16 years old. (c. 874, sec. 1:2)
3. Must be a Catholic who has been baptized, confirmed and receives Eucharist weekly. (c. 874, sec. 1:3)
4. Must live a life which is consistent with the Catholic faith, teachings, the Bible and life of Christ. (c. 874, sec. 1:3)
5. Must be a registered member at a parish and attending weekly Sunday Eucharist. (c. 857, sec. 1:2; 862)
6. A baptized person who belongs to a non-Catholic church may be part of the baptism as a "Christian Witness. It is required that one practicing Catholic be the godparent along with the Christian Witness. (c. 874, sec. 2)
7. A parent may not be godparent of their own child. (c. 874, sec. 1:5)
8. A non-baptized person may not be admitted as a godparent or a Christian Witness. (c. 874, sec. 2)
9. Every effort must be made to have the godparents present. In cases where this is not possible, a proxy may stand in place of the godparent. The proxy must be a practicing, fully initiated Catholic as stated above. (c. 875)
